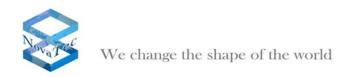
#### **Call Home Job Database**

A wrong setting of the flag "Unicode Compression" in the job.mdb has been corrected. The wrong
flag lead to the problem, that the IP address of the target systems saved in the database included
a trailing whitespace. This lead to problems using NGN-MC. NGN-MC can not work with the
corrupted IP address and therefore could not connect to the target systems.
 Customers going to use NovaTec NGN-MC or NovaTec NAMES products in the future and
intend to use the actual NMS data base to import in NAMES, shall use this NMS version.

The NMS software itself has not been changed, only the job database in the installation package has been changed.

#### 3. Install and start NMS 7.1.1.1:

- Please uninstall all previous NovaTec NMS releases.
- Insert CD and start setup.exe.



- Insert a NMS-dongle in a USB slot. Please note that if you are using a virtual machine, you need to install an IP-USB-HUB and insert the NMS-dongle in the IP-USB-HUB.
- After installing NMS with setup.exe, start NMS by

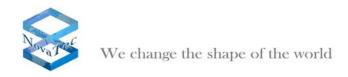

• It was not possible to import a csv file. The problem has been solved.

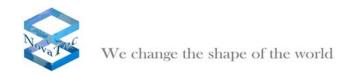
# **Network Management System**

 When NMS ran for a long time, crashes could occur while the NMS tried to send snmp-Notifications. The Bug has been solved.

# **NovaTec Network Services**

If NMS was used with TLS, then with the time the memory usage increased. The bug has been solved.

If an error occurred on starting the Network Services then the application stopped working/crashed after reporting the errors. Now, the application will be closed after error reporting. If the errors are caused by faulty settings, then these can be corrected when the Network Services are started again.

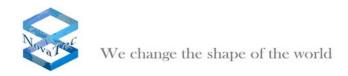

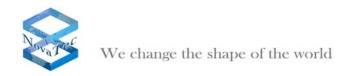

# Bug fixes in 7.0.5:

#### **Network Services:**

- Bugs description:
  - a.) The IP- address and MAC-address did not appear in each SNMP notification.
  - b.) The MAC-address was not written in the job database whenever an event reaches NMS This bugs were not in Release 7.0.3 but occurs since Release 7.0.4.
- Reason:

Network Services did not transport two information elements (IE) to NMS. These two IEs are MAC-Address-IE and IP-Address-IE.
